# Companions

Companionship for people at the end of life, and those close to them.

Marie Curie's Companion volunteers provide free, personalised help and support to people at the end of life, and those close to them – at home, in hospital and over the phone.

We offer support for a few hours each week, typically for up to 12 months. Companions can:

- provide practical and emotional support to patients outside of formal clinical arrangements
- · help reduce patients' loneliness or worries
- · can help reduce patients' reliance on hospital services
- · identify other support patients, or the people caring for them, may need
- · improve people's access to additional information.


# Do You Need That Book Anymore??
