However, the station is not exclusively owned by Home Church Scotland, their team is comprised of members from multiple churches who are passionate about using Home Radio to connect and provide a platform for Christians throughout Scotland.



Companions

Companionship for people at the end of life, and those close to them.

Marie Curie's Companion volunteers provide free, personalised help and support to people at the end of life, and those close to them – at home, in hospital and over the phone.

We offer support for a few hours each week, typically for up to 12 months.

Companions can:

- provide practical and emotional support to patients outside of formal clinical arrangements
- help reduce patients' loneliness or worries
- can help reduce patients' reliance on hospital services
- identify other support patients, or the people caring for them, may need
- improve people's access to additional information.

Why not donate them to help raise funds for the Gishyita Housing Project, with the added benefit that it will make space and make a huge difference to someone in Rwanda.

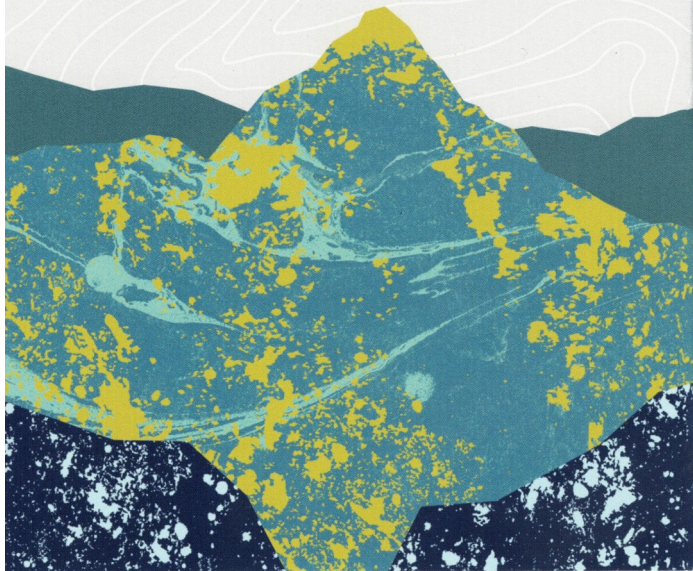

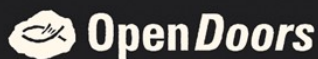
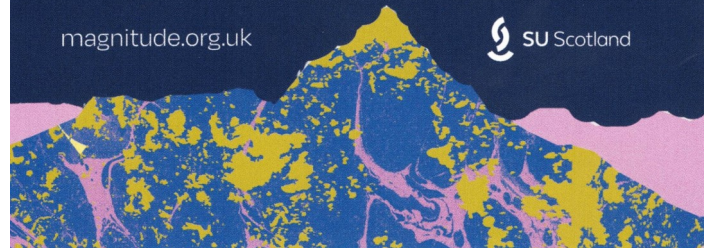
WE ARE MAGNITUDE
